1	Volunteer as a member of the Colorguard Prop/Equipment Crew during Marching Season (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a member of the Equipment Truck Crew during Marching Season (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a member of the Equipment Truck Crew during Concert/Winter Season (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a member of the Grill Team throughout the year (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a member of the Winterguard Floor Crew (students only)
1	Work one shift of spirit wear sales throughout the year (parents only)
