1	Volunteer as a member of the Equipment Truck Crew during Marching Season (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a member of the Equipment Truck Crew during Concert/Winter Season (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a member of the Winterguard Floor Crew (students only)
1	Work one shifts of spirit wear sales throughout the year (parents only)
1	Volunteer as a Bus Chaperone throughout the year (parents only)

4. ONCE LOGGED IN, SELECT "POINT SYSTEM" TO VIEW ACCUMULATED ACTIVITY FEE REDUCTION PLAN POINTS.
