Disney Trip FAQs

1. What will the weather be like in Orlando, and what kinds of clothing should I pack?

The average temperatures in Orlando for this time of year are 65-75 degrees for the high and 45-55 degrees for the low. Intermittent rain showers are not uncommon for Orlando at this time of the year. Be sure to bring a jacket and a small collapsible umbrella if you have one. Please refer to the internet for up-to-date weather forecasts prior to packing.

2. Will I need to pack my concert attire?

No! You will just need your generic band t-shirt for the Disney workshop.

3. How much money should I bring for food and souvenirs?

Each of the students will receive a \$90 debit card that can be used for breakfast/dinner over the course of the trip. (lunch is not included in the trip cost) The cost breakdown is \$15 x 2 for breakfast, \$20 x 3 for dinner. The students will be provided a special breakfast at the park on Sunday, April 14th. Please be sure to take a picture of your debit card once you receive it! If you plan a bit on the high-side at \$15.00-20.00 per meal, \$75.00-\$100.00 should be more than enough to cover lunches. However, bringing a little extra for snacks and souvenirs would be a good idea as well.

4. Can I keep my prescription medication, over-the-counter medication, and/or inhaler with me, or do I need to turn it in?

Please refer to the included *Medication Form* for details as to the MISD policy for both prescription and over-the-counter medications and their distribution while on campus or on a school related trip. Specific information regarding the use of inhalers is also included on this document. We will be strictly adhering to the guidelines as they are outlined in this document throughout the duration of our trip.

5. What are the luggage and carry-on guidelines for American Airlines?

Please refer to the American Airlines policies for both carry-on and checked baggage. Each person is allowed one small personal item and one small carry-on item that each qualify under the American/United Airlines weight and dimension limitations. Please refer to the specific information regarding carry-on electronic devices and liquids.

Each person is also allowed one bag to be checked under the plane. This cost is included in the trip package. Please refer to the weight and dimension limitations as set by American/United Airlines. All checked bags will be weighed on Friday morning prior to our departure. Please plan ahead and bring only what you need within the travel guidelines.

Instead of incurring the cost of additional and oversized checked instruments, the following instruments will be sent to Orlando via a rented cargo van driven by Dr. Hart: bass clarinet, bassoon, alto sax, tenor sax, bari sax, trumpet, french horn, trombone, euphonium, tuba, and percussion. We will load instruments into the cargo van on Wednesday, April 10th at the end of each band's rehearsals.

The following instruments will not be checked and should be either considered as your carry-on item or should at least fit within your carry-on item: piccolo, flute, oboe, and b-flat clarinet.

6. How are we getting to the airport on Friday?

We will be traveling to the airport on school buses. We will all depart at the same time according to the itinerary. We will have a District truck to transport your checked baggage to the airport. You should keep your carry-on and/or personal items with you on the bus.

All tickets will be distributed at the ticket counter upon airline check-in. You must have the photo ID that exactly matches your ticket. If you do not, you may not be going to Orlando with us.

7. I've never been to an airport. What do I need to know?

Stay together and don't wander off by yourself. Keep track of your ID and boarding pass at all times and have them both ready to present to security and airport personnel at any time. Don't leave your luggage, carry-on, and/or personal items unattended at any time.

Nothing is funny at the airport. Security is tight and jokes are not taken lightly. Please be prepared to remove your shoes at security checkpoints. Personal electronics such as laptops will also be inspected.

8. How can my parents get in touch with me while I'm in Orlando?

If you have a cell phone of your own, bring it and a charger. Cell phones, though annoying at times, are the best way for your parents to reach you. They can also contact the hotel at the number below:

9. Who do I contact if I have a question about something or need help?

We have roughly a 6:1 student to chaperone ratio on the trip. MISD recommends a 20:1 student to chaperone ratio for high school groups. We are well within the MISD guidelines.

Our chaperones will serve as the first contact person if you need assistance with something. Each chaperone will be assigned several students to monitor and check-in with on a regular basis including morning and evening hotel room checks. Each chaperone will closely monitor their designated student group and be on hand if the need for assistance should arise. The chaperones will be in constant contact with the directors at all times. Chaperones will exchange cell phone numbers with each of the students whom they are monitoring.

10. Is it a good idea for me to wander off by myself while on any portion of this trip?

Absolutely no one should wander off by themselves at anytime on this trip. It is always safer to travel in larger groups than smaller ones, so please use common sense and travel in groups of at least 2-3.

11. If there is one thing that will make this trip fun and successful for everyone involved, what would that one thing be?

Be where you are supposed to be, when you are supposed to be there! Punctuality is of the utmost importance on any group trip. Many other people are depending upon you to be on time all of the time. This is not an issue for which the directors or chaperones will have any tolerance. Plan to be early.

12. Will transportation be provided back to Summit from DFW on Monday evening? How will I get home?

No district transportation will be provided from DFW on Monday evening. Parents should arrange to pick their children up at the airport baggage claim area on Monday evening.

13. I've packed everything I think I'll need, but I feel as though I've forgotten something. What might that be?

Did you remember to pack your generic band t-shirt, and instrument? Did you pack your cell phone charger? Have you turned in your **medication form**? Do you have any prescription and/or over-the-counter **medications** that you need to turn-in? Do you have your **photo ID** that exactly matches your ticket?
